Competition Rules: The Competition is organized according to the ICR and FIS Masters rules.

Authorized Competitors: Female and Male, member of FIS, age group 1986 and older, who are registered with their National Ski Association, and have personally signed the FIS Athlete's Declaration, and been issued a valid licence by their National Assotiation, may be permitted to compete (FIS ICR 208.2)

Entry fee: 15 Euro per race day.
Ski lift tickets for both days will be available for racers at discounted price. It should be paid with the bibs distribution.
