## Competition rules

The competitions will be held in compliance with FIS International Competition Rules and FIS FESA CONTINENTAL CUP Rules. All athletes must have an active FIS Codes.

The competitions are announced according ICR 341ff. for:

Category	Years of birth (season 2025/26)
Women	2005 and older
Women U20	2006, 2007
Men	2005 and older
Men U20	2006, 2007

Athletes can only start one age category higher:

- i.e. only U 18 athletes (no U 16 athletes) can start in the U 20 category
- U20 athletes should start in their category

If an athlete competes in a higher category, the timekeeping service must be informed separately by the respective National Ski Association.

According to ICR. Art. 313, entries must be made online. The registration must be reported by the National Ski Association to the following addresses:

For competitors from FESA nations in the Cross-Country Commission there will be no entry fee for max. 40 per big nation / 20 per small nation. For all other competitors (including regional teams) over the quota there will be an entry fee of EUR 15,00 per competition.

Non-Members FESA Cross-Country Commission (i.e. Basic FESA members) and Non-FESA Countries:

Entry Fee EUR 25,00 per competition.

Payment only in cash in the Race Office with the BIB distribution in the morning. Registration must be made through the National Ski Association for all athletes.

### Fluor-Ban:

*ICR: 222.8 Fluorinated ski wax prohibition. Use of fluorinated wax or tuning products containing fluorine is prohibited for all FIS disciplines and levels. Fluorinated wax can be a competitive advantage and its use in competition will result in disqualification. (see competition rules and equipment specifications.) It is the responsibility of the respective team to ensure compliance with the FIS-ICR.*

## Accommodation

The Organising Committee (OC) Nové Město na Moravě will arrange accommodation for all FESA countries in accordance with the **FESA Cup Rules 2025/2026**.

Bookings shall be made **exclusively via the official accommodation booking form attached to this invitation**.

The accommodation cost will not exceed the limit set by the regulations of the FIS FESA Continental Cup.

**Preliminary booking (numbers only)** — including the number of competitors, officials, and required single/double rooms — must be submitted **no later than 14 January 2026** using the official accommodation booking form.

Final booking for accommodation must be submitted by 30 January 2026.

Final booking by name must be submitted by 10 February 2026

After 30 January 2026, changes to the number of rooms will be possible only up to a maximum of **10%**, subject to availability.

Accommodation will be allocated on a **first-come, first-served basis**.






