Registration

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the final team entries with a FIS Entry Form to czechfreeski@seznam.cz no later than 10 days prior to the first day of official training. Entry deadline March, 20 2018.

Be aware, that there are some new rules: FIS Rule EC 3.1:

FIS Points requirement to participate in European Cup Competitions slopestyle men Minimum 10 FIS points in Slopestyle, Halfpipe or Big Air FIS Rule EC 3.2:

In case of a large starting field at certain competitions, the field may be capped at 70 competitors in the men Slopestyle event.
